

Background & Methodology

Conducted approximately 400 surveys per state with residents who drive at least once a week

- Fielding took place February 17, 2017 – March 01, 2017
- Utilized a proprietary online market research panel
- State results are weighted by age and gender

- Driving Habits
- Distracted Driving Opinions
- Passenger Behaviors

Statistical Statement:

The AAA Consumer Pulse™ Survey was conducted online among drivers living in The Auto Club Group territory from February 17, 2017 – March 01, 2017. Approximately 400 residents in each state completed the survey. State results have a margin of error of ± 4.9 percentage points. Responses are weighted by gender and age to ensure reliable and accurate representation of the adult population (18+).
